- **5.3)** 中学一年级申请者须以小学会考成绩,同时附上中学一年级或最近学期考试成绩。其他学年申请者 须以最近一学年的成绩。
- 5.4) 小学四, 五, 六年级申请者须以最近一学年的成绩。

6) 申请手续:

- 6.1) 申请者须接受新加坡颜氏公会教育奖助学金委员会的最后评决。

- 3.1) 大学普通学位:每名每年新币\$1,200。 初级/工艺学院:每名每年新币\$500。 中学:每名每年新币\$350。 小学四,五,六年级:每名每年新币\$250。
- 3.2) 教育奖助学金委员会可增减助学金颁发名额。

4) 助学金申请者资格:

- 4.1) 申请者必须为新加坡颜氏公会会员或会员子女。
- 4.2) 申请者家长经入会满一年。
- 4.3) 申请者品格,操行须优良。
- 4.4) 申请者须是在本国教育部学校就读的在籍学生。
- 4.5) 积极和活跃参与公会活动的申请者将优先被录取。

RULES FOR APPLICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

- 1) Application for the scholarship is open to all members and their children, who are still attending school or tertiary institution. Selection is strictly based on the academic results. The objective of the Scholarship is to assist them to succeed in their studies, later in life and thereafter contribute to the local community, including our Association.
- 2) All successful applicants are selected and approved by the Education Committee. The scholarships will be funded from the Education Fund of the Association.

3.2) The Educational Committee shall decide on the total number of Awards to be given.

4) CRITERIA

- 4.1) All applicants must be a member or children of a member of the Association at the time of application.
- 4.2) Parents of Applicants must be a member of our Association for at least 1 year.
- 4.3) Applicants must be of good conduct and character.
- 4.4) Applicants must be studying in schools under MOE at that time of application.
- 4.5) Applicants who have contributed and participated in our Association's activities will be given priority.
- 4.6) Applications with incomplete details will be disqualified.
- 4.7) Applicants are not allowed to apply for both the Bursary and Scholarship in the same year. Applicants who apply for both Awards will be disqualified.

5) ACADEMIC RESULTS

- 5.1) First-year undergraduates will be assessed based on their A Level results together with the enrolment and acceptance letter from the University. For others, they will be assessed based on their previous year's Examinations results.
- 5.2) First-year Junior College/Polytechnic students will be assessed based on their O Level and the latest examination results in the Junior College/Polytechnic. For others, they will be based on their previous year's Examination results.
- 5.3) First-year Secondary School students will be assessed based on their PSLE and the latest examination results. For others, they will be assessed based on their previous year's Examination results.
- 5.4) Primary 4/5/6 students will be assessed based on their previous year's Examination results.

6) APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 6.1) Applicants must abide by the Rules stipulated by the Education Committee and their decision is final.
- 6.2) In the event when there is any discrepancy in the Rules, the Education Committee has the rights to make alteration and inform the Board Council in due course.
- 6.3) Applications received after the closing date will not be considered.
- 7) The Current Rules have been updated and approved by the 29th Board Council at the 22nd Council Meeting held on 19/3/2021.

3.2) The Educational Committee may decide the final total number of Awards to be given out.

4) BURSARY APPLICATION CRITERIA

- 4.1) All applicants must be a member or children of a member of the Association at the time of application.
- 4.2) Parents of Applicants must be a member of our Association for at least 1 year.
- 4.3) Applicants must be of good conduct and character.
- 4.4) Applicants must be studying in schools under MOE at the time of application.
- 4.5) Applicants who have contributed and participated in our Association's activities will be given priority.
- 4.6) Gross monthly household income (before CPF contribution) not exceeding \$4500, **or** gross per capita income (before CPF contribution) not exceeding \$1500.
- 4.7) Parents must submit pay slip and CPF statement for the past 15 months. For unemployed, they also need to submit CPF statement for the past 15 months. Applications with incomplete details will be disqualified.
- 4.8) Applicants are not allowed to apply for both the Bursary and Scholarship in the same year. Applicant that has applied for both Awards will be disqualified.

5) ACADEMIC RESULTS

- 5.1) First-year University students will be considered based on their A Level results together with the enrolment and acceptance letter from the University. For others, assessment will be based on their previous year's Examinations results.
- 5.2) First-year Junior College / Polytechnic students will be considered based on their O Level and the latest examination results. For others, assessment will be based on their previous year's Examination results.
- 5.3) First-year Secondary students will be based on their PSLE and the latest examination results. For others, assessment will be based on their previous year's Examination results.
- 5.4) For Primary 4/5/6 students, assessment will be based on their previous year's Examination results.

6) APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 6.1) Applicants must abide by the Rules stipulated by the Education Committee and their decision is final.
- 6.2) In the event when there is any discrepancy in the Rules, the Education Committee has the rights to make alteration and inform the Board Council in due course.
